SOUTHEAST ALASKA COMMERCIAL GEODUCK FISHERY ANNOUNCEMENT

The following areas will be open for the commercial harvest of geoduck for live sale from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Wednesday, February 11, and from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Thursday, February 12, 2026:

Nehenta Bay (Subdistrict 101-29-001): will be open for a remaining harvest of 16,000 pounds of geoduck;

Middle Gravina Island (Subdistrict 101-29-002): will be open for a guideline harvest level of 42,600 pounds of geoduck;

Kaigani Strait (Subdistrict 103-30-001): will be open for a remaining harvest of 16,000 pounds of geoduck;

For a description of the above areas, please refer to the Southeast Alaska commercial geoduck fishery announcement dated August 29, 2025, announcing the open areas and their guideline harvest level. All geoducks harvested must be clearly labeled with the date of harvest, the harvester's name, and the location of harvest. Companies buying geoduck must contact the Fish and Game, Ketchikan office with a harvest report before 12:00 noon on Friday, February 13, 2026.

State offices will be closed Monday, February 16, for Presidents' Day.
