Requirements for Participants:

- The CFEC permit holder must report the harvest for the trip, including discards, by species, to ADF&G by telephoning **(907) 424-7215** within 24 hours of completing a trip.
- No more than 40% by weight of the shrimp brought on board a vessel during a trip may be pink shrimp and no more than 5% may be other pandalid species (adopted March 2022); discards of pandalid species are reported as deadloss on fish tickets.
- Log sheets and shrimp catch sampling forms must be completed and returned with each fish ticket; log sheets must have entries for each tow as specified and catch sampling forms must be completed at least once per day in each section fished.
- Permit holder agrees to accommodate a department observer upon request.
