-KMA includes all waters of the Kodiak Island archipelago








- Road Zone (KRZ)

















# Sport Fishing Effort in the KMA




# Angler-days of Sport Fishing Effort and Number of Anglers in the KMA, 2013-2022

## Kodiak Road Zone (KRZ)

**Proposal 47:** Increase the waters of Monashka Creek open to sport fishing and allow snagging in Monashka Bay year-round

**Proposal 48:** Increase the coho salmon bag limit in Miam, Sacramento and Saltery Cove drainages




## KRZ Sport Fishing Regulations for Proposals 47 & 48

- KRZ salmon bag limits:
  - 5 salmon per day, no more than 2 sockeye or 2 coho salmon
  - September 16-December 31, only 1 may be a coho salmon
  - Exceptions: Monashka Bay, Pillar and Monashka Creeks, Mill Bay and Mission Beach; coho bag limit- 2 per day year-round




# Monashka Creek Sport Fishing Regulations for Proposal 47

- Monashka Creek is closed upstream of a marker approximately 50 yards upstream of the highway
- Monashka Creek is closed to fishing from the east bank from the bridge downstream 100 yds to a regulatory sign
- Bag limit for coho salmon is 2 per day year-round
- Snagging is prohibited in Monashka Bay from January 1 through July 5




# Saltery, Miam and Sacramento Coho Salmon Bag Limits for Proposal 48



- Each of these drainages are fairly remote
- Require off-road travel that limits access and angler effort
- Some of the larger coho runs in the KRZ, though unmonitored

# King Salmon

**Proposal 49:** Reduce the bag and possession limit of king salmon in the salt waters of the KMA from May 15 through July 31 and establish an annual limit from April 1 through August 31

## KMA Saltwater King Salmon Regulations:

- 2 king salmon per day,  
2 in possession
- No annual limit
- No closed season





# Kodiak Area Saltwater King Salmon Management Plan

Provisions of the management plan:


- GHL of 11,000 king salmon harvest annually in KMA
- Harvest estimated through SWHS minus Monashka Bay
- BOF will consider options if GHL is exceeded, if they find it necessary:
  - Reduce nonresident limit to 1
  - Restrict harvest by guides while clients on board
  - Restrict harvest to <28”
  - Reduce resident limit




# Rockfish Management Districts and Area Affected by Recent EO's

- Management plan began 2020, restrict inseason or preseason by EO:
  - Annual limit for nonresidents
  - Reduce bag limit for nonresidents
  - Reduce the bag limit by area
  - Establish a rockfish season
  - Reduce the resident rockfish limit
- Guideline Harvest Range (GHR) of 0-26,000 black rockfish
- Manage for sustainable harvests within specific areas

## Other KMA Sportfishing Proposals

- Proposal 44: Prohibit the use of multiple hooks, also known as treble hooks, for sportfishing in the freshwater of the KMA.
- Proposal 45: Prohibit use of treble hooks and the use of bait while sport fishing in all freshwaters of Kodiak Island, including stocked lakes and streams.
- Proposal 46: Allow snagging as a legal means of harvest for sockeye salmon in freshwaters of the KMA.
- Proposal 51: Prohibit commercial transport vessels transporting hunters or nature viewers from engaging in sport or subsistence fishing while clients are on board.
