

My Name is Dean Anderson I am 67 years old and I was born in Seward Ak. I have fished for salmon in Chignik for over 49 years and in PWS for 7 years. I have been running my own boat for 43 of those years.

Proposal 109 I am opposed to because it's just re-allocating the fishing area to lagoon fisherman.

Proposal 110 needs clarification as it implies that the depth is the issue so one must clarify with a number for overall depth. For example my body web in the deepest part of my net is 3.25" mesh (which is normal mesh size for pink net in PWS) by 300 meshes and 8 meshes of 3.75" border strip and 25 meshes of 5' chaffing gear for a grand total of 333 meshes. This net happens to be shallower than what P-110 proposes but has a higher number of meshes.

Proposal 111. Very much in favor.

Proposal 112 Mostly agree with this proposal except there is no escape plan. What happens when there is strong run of reds and a case where it appears that the king escapement won't make its minimum escapement no mater what you close down? Does over-escapement matter 350,000 more than was needed last year there must be a tipping point!

I propose additional options for lagoon opening areas that might increase opportunity on sockeye and reduce king catch.

The following page identifies a chart of Chignik Lagoon, on the south side of the lagoon only the flats would be available so only wen tide is at least 4-5' or so and on the north side of the lagoon u might have a limited amount of area at low water in edition to high water.
