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Proposal 2

non-electronic

In big game hunts limited to bow and arrow only, you may not use:

- any type of electronic device, or light attached to the bow, arrow, or arrowhead, except a non-illuminating camera or a lighted nock on the end of an arrow, or a scope or electronic sight that does not project light externally;
- scopes or other devices attached to the bow or arrow for optical enhancement;

These items are already legal in hunts not limited to archery only.

Allowing use of additional archery equipment is an increase in opportunity.

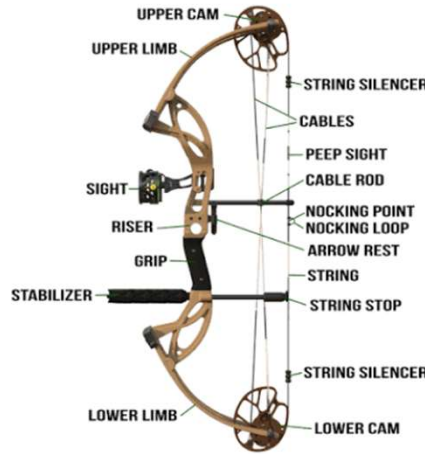

Verifier: Magnifying lens that screws into the peep sight. Clears up the sight pins.

Clarifier: Magnifying lens that screws into the peep sight and is used in conjunction with a lens on a scope. Clears up the target.

Prism: Non-magnifying lens for scope that makes the target appear higher than it is. Allows archers to shoot farther distances.
